This ongoing group will be led by a Licensed Clinical Social Worker and focuses on support and psycho-education for adult women who are survivors of trauma. When you have experienced a traumatic event in your life, for example physical abuse, sexual abuse, rape, childhood severe neglect/abandonment or domestic violence, it is helpful to talk with other people who are facing similar challenges.
